Once you are an approved member, you can scan this QR Code to download the Global Entry app prior to traveling internationally. Then, while in flight and before your return trip lands in the U.S., simply use the app to complete the customs declaration and arrival process.

# Global Entry Membership

Global Entry membership allows international travelers to skip the long wait in customs lines. Instead, members can use the portals available at most major U.S. airports, avoiding the traditional customs declaration and arrival processes. And with the Global Entry app, members can also choose to validate their arrival to the U.S. using their iOS or Android device prior to entering the customs inspection area.

Global Entry membership also includes TSA Pre✓ membership, for expedited security screening upon departure, at all U.S. airports for both domestic and international travel.

## Who Qualifies for Global Entry?

U.S. citizens, lawful permanent residents of the U.S., and citizens of foreign partner countries are eligible for Global Entry membership provided they have not:

- Been convicted of a criminal offense in any country.
- Been found in violation of customs, immigration or agricultural laws.
- Provided false or incomplete information on their application.
- Been the subject of an investigation by any federal, state, or local law enforcement.

CBP reserves the right to deny applicants who cannot be verified as low-risk travelers or who do not meet other program requirements.

## The Benefits of Global Entry

- Priority processing when arriving in the U.S.
- Expedited security screening when departing the U.S., through TSA Pre✓ membership
- Mobile app now available
- Citizens from the following countries are eligible for Global Entry: Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Bahrain, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Germany, India, Japan, Jordan, Mexico, Netherlands, Panama, Singapore, South Korea, Switzerland, Taiwan, United Arab Emirates, and the United Kingdom. CBP is regularly looking to expand foreign partnerships.

## How to Apply

- Complete the online application at <https://tftp.dhs.gov>.
- Once your application is conditionally approved, you will receive an email notification and may be asked to schedule an interview at one of the Global Entry Enrollment Centers. (You may also choose the Enrollment on Arrival option at select U.S. airports.)
- During the interview, a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Officer will determine your eligibility and collect biometric information (e.g. fingerprints, photo). You will be asked to provide a valid passport and one other form of identification such as a driver's license or ID card. If you are a lawful permanent resident of the U.S., you must provide your permanent resident card.
- If approved, your membership is immediately valid for five years, expiring on your birthday. You do not need your Global Entry card to travel and enjoy member benefits. You only need your passport to activate a customs declaration and arrival session at a Global Entry portal.

## How Much Does it Cost?

As of October 1, 2024, a non-refundable \$120 (USD) fee will be charged at the time of application submission. Minors under 18 are free when a parent or legal guardian is also approved in a Trusted Traveler Program.
